#### **Exodus 1:21**

Since the midwives feared God, He gave them families.

#### **Exodus 2:25**

God saw the Israelites, and He took notice.

#### **Exodus 3: 5**

“Do not come closer,” He said. “Remove the sandals from your feet, for the place where you are standing is holy ground.”

#### **Exodus 4:12**

Now go! I will help[a] you speak and I will teach you what to say.”

#### **Exodus 5: 1b**

Later, Moses and Aaron went in and said to Pharaoh, “This is what Yahweh, the God of Israel, says: Let My people go, so that they may hold a festival for Me in the wilderness.”

#### **Exodus 6: 5**

Furthermore, I have heard the groaning of the Israelites, whom the Egyptians are forcing to work as slaves, and I have remembered My covenant.

#### **Exodus 7: 5**

The Egyptians will know that I am Yahweh when I stretch out My hand against Egypt and bring out the Israelites from among them.”

#### **Exodus 8:18**

The magicians tried to produce gnats using their occult practices, but they could not. The gnats remained on man and beast.

#### **Exodus 9: 15-16**

By now I could have stretched out My hand and struck you and your people with a plague, and you would have been obliterated from the earth. 16 However, I have let you live for this purpose: to show you My power and to make My name known in all the earth.

#### **Exodus 10: 3b**

So Moses and Aaron went into Pharaoh and told him, “This is what Yahweh, the God of the Hebrews, says: How long will you refuse to humble yourself before Me? Let My people go, that they may worship Me

**Exodus 11: 3a**

The Lord gave the people favor in the sight of the Egyptians.

**Exodus 12:13**

The blood will serve as a sign on the houses where you are; I will see the blood, and I will pass over you, and there shall be no plague to destroy you when I strike the land of Egypt.

**Exodus 13:22**

The pillar of cloud did not withdraw from before the people by day, nor the pillar of fire by night.

**Exodus 14:14**

The Lord will fight for you; and you, keep silent.

**Exodus 15: 3**

The Lord is a mighty warrior; The Lord is his name.

**Exodus 16: 4a**

And the Lord said to Moses, Behold, I will rain bread for you from the heavens.

**Exodus 17: 6a**

Behold, I will stand before you on the rock of Horeb; thou shalt strike the rock, and water will come out of it, and the people shall drink.

**Exodus 18:10**

And Jethro said, Blessed, be the Lord, who delivered you out of the hand of the Egyptians, and out of the hand of Pharaoh; who delivered the people out of the hand of the Egyptians!

**Exodus 19: 6a**

You will be to me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.

**Exodus 20: 3**

You will have no other gods before me.

**Exodus 21:15**

Anyone who hits their father or mother will be punished with death.

**Exodus 22:28**

Thou shalt not curse God, neither shalt thou curse the prince of thy people.

**Exodus 23: 2**

Thou shalt not follow a multitude to do evil; and thou shalt not testify, siding with many, to violate righteousness.

**Exodus 24:17**

The appearance of the glory of the Lord was like consuming fire on the top of the mountain in the sight of the children of Israel.

**Exodus 25: 2**

Speak to the children of Israel. May they bring me an offering; you will receive it for me from every man who will do it with a good heart.

**Exodus 26:30**

You will set up the tabernacle after the pattern shown to you on the mountain.

**Exodus 27:20**

You shall order the children of Israel to bring you for the candlestick pure oil of crushed olives, to keep the lamps going continually.

**Exodus 28: 3**

You shall speak to all those who are clever, to whom I have given a mind full of understanding; and they will make Aaron's garments, that he may be consecrated and exercise my priesthood.

**Exodus 29:45**

I will dwell among the children of Israel, and I will be their God.

**Exodus 30:29**

You will sanctify these things, and they will be very holy; whatever touches them will be sanctified.

**Exodus 31: 6b**

I have put intelligence in the minds of all those who are clever so that they do whatever I have ordered you [...]

**Exodus 32:33**

The Lord said to Moses, He who sinned against me will I blot out of my book.

**Exodus 33:19**

The LORD said, I will cause all my mercy to pass before you, and will proclaim the name of the LORD before you; I have mercy on whom I have mercy and mercy on whom I have mercy.

**Exodus 34: 6**

And the LORD passed over before him and cried out, The LORD, the LORD, the merciful and compassionate God, slow to anger, and rich in loving-kindness and faithfulness.

**Exodus 35: 21**

All those who were drawn up of the heart and moved with goodwill came and brought an offering to the Lord for the work of the Tent of Meeting, for all his service, and the holy vestments.

**Exodus 36: 5b**

The people bring much more than is necessary to do the work which the Lord has commanded to be done.

**Exodus 37:29**

He [Betsaleel] made the oil for the holy anointing, and the fragrant, pure perfume, composed according to the art of the perfumer.

**Exodus 38:22**

Bezaleel the son of Uri, the son of Hur, of the tribe of Judah, did all that the Lord commanded Moses.

**Exodus 39:43**

Moses examined all the work; and, behold, they had done as the LORD had commanded, so they had done. And Moses blessed them.

**Exodus 40:34**

Then the cloud covered the Tent of Meeting, and the glory of the Lord filled the tabernacle.
